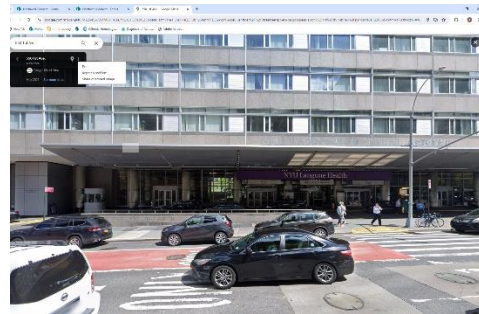
We look forward to welcoming you to NYC for the Pulmonary Pathology Society Biennial Meeting.
